



Dear Traveler,

Thank you for your interest in Pastor Betzer's 2018 Israel tour with an optional Jordan pre-Israel extension.

The dates of the Jordan and Israel combined tour are April 16 – May 4, and the dates of the Israel-only tour are April 21 – May 4. The cost is \$7,285.00 for the combined Jordan and Israel tour and \$5,340.00 for the Israel only tour. These prices are per person, based on double occupancy. Our tour price covers absolutely everything. Your only out-of-pocket expenses are most of your lunches and your personal spending money. This price is for departure from Fort Myers, FL. If you live in another part of the country, our travel agent will be glad to assist you with your flight to meet up with our group at our overseas departure city, which will be Miami with El Al Airlines. This is a non-stop flight from Miami to Tel Aviv, which we are excited to offer! We will have charter buses to transport you from the First Assembly parking lot to the Miami airport. To fly from a different departure city, there may be an additional cost, or if you would like to upgrade your airfare or make your own flight arrangements, you may do that. Please note these choices on your registration form, and our travel agent will be in touch with you.

If you are a single and would like to have a roommate assigned to you, please write "looking for a roommate" on your registration form. We will make every attempt to put you together with a roommate, but if a roommate isn't available, you will need to pay the single supplement amount.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS – You must be able to walk approximately 3 – 4 miles unassisted, be comfortable participating in 6 - 8 hours of some type of physical activities each day, walk for some distance on uneven surfaces, negotiate several flights of stairs, get on and off the bus and get around without the assistance of another individual. Canes or walking sticks are allowed. This tour is not for travelers using wheelchairs or scooters. Travelers using walkers, crutches or other mobility aids must travel with a companion who can assist them.

It's also very important that you review your insurance options. If you are 85 years old or younger, Israeli medical insurance is provided for you while we are in both Jordan and Israel. This does not cover our visit to Bethlehem. Also, this medical insurance does not cover things like hotel expenses and flight changes, if you need to extend your stay due to unforeseen medical problems, which can add a lot to your cost. This is why we strongly encourage you to purchase additional insurance from someone like Travelex. DAY 1 (Mon. April 16): We leave the States for a Journey into the magnificent Jordanian dessert, holding some of the most astonishing pearls of the ancient world.

DAY 2 (Tues. April 17): Flying over the Atlantic Ocean and over Europe, we reach the shores of God's land. Upon our arrival to the Ben Gurion airport, we will be met by our guide and enjoy an **Israeli Breakfast** at a nearby hotel. Driving through Jerusalem, we will be transferred to our hotel at the **Dead Sea**, the lowest place on earth! The rest of the day will be free. Those who wish will be able to enjoy the hotel's wonderful SPA facilities, pool or private beach.

DAY 3 (Wed. April 18): ARAVAH VALLEY

Today, as we leave the Dead Sea, we will enter the vast wilderness, as we begin traveling down south through the Aravah Valley. On the way, we will make a stop at the **Timna Park**, with its unique natural formations. We will visit the copper mines from which material was extracted for the making of the tools of the Temple. We will also view what is known as Solomon's Pillars and the remains of an ancient Egyptian worship site. Before reaching Eilat, we will stop at **Kibbutz Yotvata**, known for its outstanding dairy products, produced right here in the middle of the desert. Right before the sun sets down, we will arrive to the beautiful city of **Eilat**, located on the shores of the **Red Sea**, with a breathtaking view of the Red Mountains of *Edom* and the Gulf of Aqaba.

DAY 4 (Thurs. April 19): CAMEL RIDING & FREE DAY IN EILAT

Eilat, known as the "City of the eternal sun" is a world known resort area. It offers a variety of different marine and other activities. We will begin the day at a **camel ranch**, where you will be able to enjoy a short ride on a camel. The rest of the day will be free. You may want to dive or snorkel in the Red Sea, do some parachute or water skiing, visit the underwater observatory, catch a 3D movie at the IMAX theatre, do some hiking in the mountains surrounding Eilat, or just enjoy a restful day around the hotel's swimming pool.

DAY 5 (Fri. April 20): WADIRAM

A very short drive from Eilat will take us to the Aravah border crossing, from which we will enter Jordan. Once in Jordan, following the footsteps of Moses and the Children of Israel we will take the **King's Highway** towards **Wadi Ram**, one of the most beautiful desert regions of the eastern Mediterranean made famous by the exploits of Lawrence of Arabia. We will spend the day touring this magnificent region by jeeps. In the afternoon, we will drive to the breathtaking ancient city of **Petra**. Once the capital of the Nabatean people, this rose red city is considered one of the wonders of the ancient world.

DAY 6 (Sat. April 21): PETRA

Today, will be dedicated to visiting the breathtaking ancient city of **Petra**. Walking or riding an Arabian horse, we will go through the "Siq," a magnificent canyon that will take us to the **Treasury Monument**, carved out of the red rock. Other impressive remains are the ancient tombs, the Cardo Street, the Triumphal Arch of Adrian and the Court building, as well as a spring known as "Moses Spring". If time permits, those who wish will be able to climb to the **High Place**, where the cities altar is found and an amazing overview of the entire area can be seen. After we enjoy a nice group lunch, we will walk all the way back (those who are tired may try to rent a donkey).

DAY 7 (Sun. April 22): RETURNING TO THE PROMISED LAND

We will leave the beautiful Petra behind us and start making our way back north to reach **Mt. Nebo**. It was from here that Moses looked onto the Promised Land before dying (Deuteronomy 34). After seeing this beautiful view

ourselves we will drive to the **Jordan River** and cross it at the same place where Joshua and the Children of Israel crossed the river into Israel (Joshua 2). We will be transferred to our hotel in Tel-Aviv.

DAY 8 (Mon. April 23): COASTAL PLAIN

After a rich Israeli breakfast, we begin our tour of Israel at **Caesarea**, city of Cornelius the Centurion, the first Gentile to convert (Acts 10). We will visit the Roman theatre, walk on the pier used by the apostle Paul on his way to Rome and see the impressive water aqueduct built by Herod the Great. Leaving the Mediterranean, we will travel north to **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah held the contest with 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). At noon, a memorable experience is awaiting for us, as we stop for a typical **Falafel Meal** at the Druze village of **Daliat El-Carmel**. We will also visit **Haifa**, one of Israel's main port cities for a view of the extra ordinary **Bahai Gardens**, considered one of the most beautiful handmade gardens in the world. At the end of the day, we will drive through **Nazareth**, where Jesus spent most of His life. We will make a stop at the **Mt. of Precipice** (Luke 4) for a wondrous view of Nazareth and the Valley of Armageddon. We will drive by **Cana of Galilee** where Jesus performed His first miracle at the wedding feast (John 2) and continue to our hotel in the beautiful region of Galilee.

DAY 9 (Tues. April 24): AREA OF THE TRIBE OF DAN

Today will be dedicated to the spectacular northern part of Israel. Following the accounts described in the Gospel of Luke chapter 9, we will drive through the **Hula Valley** to reach **Mt. Hermon**, where the miracle of Transfiguration occurred. We will visit the **Banias**, one of the headwaters of the **Jordan River** and site of **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter confessed Christ's divinity. From there, we will continue to the **Dan Nature Reserve**. After a refreshing walk through the beautiful reserve and a taste from the cool water, we will discover Jeroboam's Altar (I Kings 12). We will also see a city gate from the time of Abraham the Patriarch and learn about the importance of the gate in the social life of the city in the Old Testament times. Then, at **Korazim**, one of the cities cursed by Jesus (Mat. 11:20-24), we will visit the beautiful synagogue made of basalt. We will notice a carved seat used by the community's most respected members, known in the ancient sources as the *Moses Seat* (Mat. 23: 1-7). We will also see the ancient ritual bath that has been reconstructed near the synagogue, along with two large dwellings.

DAY 10 (Wed. April 25): CITIES OF JESUS' DAYS

We will begin our day climbing to **Mt. Arbel**, for a breathtaking view of the entire Sea of Galilee and the region surrounding it. We will then continue to **Sephoris**, the capital of Galilee in Jesus days. A very old tradition points out this city as the birthplace of the Virgin Mary, and most likely the place where Joseph worked as a stonemason. Here, we find remains of a synagogue, houses and one of the most impressive mosaics discovered in the land, depicting the bust of a lady, known as the "Mona Lisa" of Galilee. Driving through the **Valley of Jezreel** we will arrive at **Megiddo**. Here, we will view the excavations of 21 superimposed cities, the remains from Solomon's days (I Kings 9). Finally, we will visit the recently discovered **Magdala Synagogue**. Here, we will view remains of the synagogue and town of Mary Magdalene and record Jesus' teachings throughout the Galilee (Mathew 4).

DAY 11 (Thur. April 26): AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE

Today, we will be visiting the places where Jesus spent most of His public life and visit the sites you have read about all of your life. Using a replica of the wooden fishing boat from the disciples' time, we will sail on the **Sea of Galilee** and recall Jesus' experiences with the fishermen. We will continue to the **Mount of Beatitudes**, where Christ preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), before continuing to **Capernaum**, where Jesus taught in the synagogue and spent much of His ministry (Matthew 4). We will also visit **Mensa Christi**, the place where Jesus reappeared to His disciples after His resurrection (John 21). Driving around the lake, we will visit **Tabgha**, the place of the feeding of the 5,000 (Matthew 14). Then, we will stop by the **Jordan River** for a **Baptism service** in the same water Jesus was baptized in.

DAY 12 (Fri. April 27): JORDAN VALLEY TO JERUSALEM

Before leaving the beautiful Galilee area, we will drive by **Mt. Gilboah**, where King Saul fell on his sword and found his death (I Samuel 31). From there, we will head down south to **Beth Shean** (I Sam. 31), a Decapolis Capital mentioned in the Gospels. Here, we will walk on the ancient streets, view the Roman steam baths, the

theatre, coliseum, market and temples. We will continue down the **Jordan Valley** and reach Jesus' Baptismal Site on the **Jordan River**. Located across from **Jericho**, the oldest city in the world and a beautiful oasis (Joshua 3), it is believed to be the traditional site where Jesus was baptized by John (Mathew 3:13). We will then ride a portion of the **Old Jericho Road** used by pilgrims to ascend to Jerusalem in Jesus' days. As we make a stop along the desolated road, we will learn the meaning of Psalm 121 and better understand the story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25). We will also view one of the amazing isolated monasteries of the area, where the monks still try to follow the example of Jesus on the Mt. of Temptation. Crossing a part of the **Wilderness of Judea**, we will become acquainted with the Bedouin life and start ascending to the Golden City of the Mighty King: **JERUSALEM**.

DAY 13 (Sat. April 28): BETHLEHEM & FREE AFTERNOON

We spend the morning in **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus and the **Church of the Nativity**. We will continue to the pastoral **Shepherds' Fields**, where David raised his sheep and where the Good News about Jesus' birth was received (Luke 2). Before returning to Jerusalem, we will enjoy a **typical Middle Eastern meal** at one of Bethlehem's finest restaurants. Back in Jerusalem, the rest of the day will be free. This will allow us to rest and absorb much of the information we have come to obtain so far. You may want to use this day to stroll on your own or to do some shopping. Our tour bus will function as a shuttle and different activities will be suggested.

DAY 14 (Sun. April 29): MT. OF OLIVES - MT. OF ZION

We begin the day at the **Mt. of Olives** with a magnificent overview of Jerusalem and an explanation of its history. Then, we will walk down the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane**, the site of Jesus' betrayal (Luke 22). We will continue down the Mount of Olives and walk through the **Kidron Valley**, following the path Jesus would have taken many times in His coming and going from Bethany to the temple. We will pass a row of Second Temple monumental sepulchers, including the so-called Absalom's tomb, ending at the **Pool of Siloam**, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9). We will continue to **Peter in Gallicantu**, believed to be the site of Caiaphas' house and dungeons (Luke 22). We will end the day visiting the **Upper Room** at the Mt. of Zion.

DAY 15 (Mon. April 30): JEWISH QUARTER

Today, we will begin by visiting the Old City at the **Ophel Digs**, where we will walk on the First Century Street, used by pilgrims for centuries, while viewing the remains of the Temple and the steps used by Jesus when entering it (Luke 19, Matthew 21). After a quiet moment of prayer at the **Western Wall**, we will visit the impressive **Western Wall Tunnel**, running along the continuation of the Western Wall, to get a better understanding of how the impressive complex of the Temple Mount was constructed. We will continue to the **Jewish Quarter**, walk through the **Cardo** and **Hezekiahs Wall**, towards the **Arab Market** and bazaar and leave the Old City through the **Jaffa Gate**. At night, a memorable event awaits us, as we view the spectacular light and sound show at the **Tower of David**, telling the story of Jerusalem through the centuries.

DAY 16 (Tues. May 1): MODERN JERUSALEM

We will begin the day with a short stop at a park located in the heart of Jerusalem to view an original First Century Tomb and the **Rolling Stone** that closed it. At the **Israel Museum**, we will have a chance to visit the **Model of Jerusalem** during Jesus' time to obtain an excellent perspective of the city at His time. We will also visit the **Shrine of the Book**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed, and view the ossuary of Caiaphas and Pontious Pilate Stone. We will continue to **Yad Vashem**, the museum of the Holocaust, where we will better understand the miracle of Israel's revival and return to the Land, as promised by God. Finally, at the **Friends of Zion Museum**, we will hear about the special connection of Christians to the land and their efforts in the establishment of Israel.

DAY 17 (Wed. May 2): DEAD SEA AREA

Today, we leave Jerusalem and descend towards the **Dead Sea**, located in the lowest place in the world, 1,300 ft. below sea level! Our first stop will be at **Ein Gedi**, where David wrote some of his beautiful psalms. After a short hike, we reach the waterfall where David cut off Saul's skirt (I Samuel 24). We will continue to the astonishing ruins of **Massada**. Using a cable car, we reach Herod's magnificent fortress, the site of the Zealots' stand against Rome. Well preserved storehouses, cisterns and palaces will be among the features to visit. At noontime, we stop at **Ein Bokek** for lunch and a float on the salty sea. Before returning to Jerusalem, we will visit **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scrolls discovery.

DAY 18 (Thur. May 3): JERUSALEM'S CHRISTIAN SITES

Early in the morning, we visit the **Temple Mount** and the impressive **Dome of the Rock**. Then, we will enter **St. Stephen's Gate** and come to the **Pools of Bethesda**, where Jesus healed the lame man (John 5). After a time of singing in **St. Anne's Church**, we will view the remains of the **Antonia Fortress**, site of Jesus' trial (Mathew 27). We then follow the **Way of the Cross** out of the **Damascus Gate** to the **Garden Tomb**, the site of the crucifixion and culminate our tour with a communion at **Calvary**.

DAY 19 (Fri. May 4): Early departure for home, after fulfilling a lifetime dream of seeing, touching and breathing the very places we have only read about until now. Arriving home, our Bible will never be the same, for it will be alive in front of our eyes and in our hearts forever.
